EURES Portal Introduction



- EURES is a European cooperation network of employment services designed to facilitate the free movement of workers, provide information, advice, and recruitment/placement (job-matching).



- The EURES Job Mobility Portal connects jobseekers with employers by providing job recommendations tailored to their specific profile.

EURES in your country

EURES is a cooperation network designed to facilitate the free movement of workers within the EU-27 countries plus Switzerland, Iceland, Liechtenstein and Norway.

The network is composed of:

- **National Coordination Offices (NCOs)** – each country member of the network has appointed a National Coordination Office for EURES, responsible for coordinating the national network of Members and Partners;
- **EURES Member and EURES Partners** – provide information, placement and recruitment services to employers and jobseekers at local level;
- **European Coordination Office (ECO)** – the network is coordinated at European level, by the European Coordination Office, established within the European Labour Authority.

EURES Services

EURES services to jobseekers and employers include:

- Matching of job vacancies and CVs on the EURES portal;
- Information and guidance and other support services for workers and employers, by 1 000 EURES Advisers on the ground;
- Access to information on living and working conditions in the EU member States, such as taxation, pensions, health insurance and social security;
- Specific support services for frontier workers and employers in cross-border regions;
- Support to specific groups in the context of the EURES Targeted Mobility Scheme;
- Support to dynamic recruitment events through the European (Online) Job Days platform;
- Information on and access to post-recruitment assistance, such as language training and support with integration in the destination country.

Services for jobseekers (I)

- **Find a job**

- The EURES Portal has almost 4 million jobs available. Jobseekers can narrow down their search by country, industry, or occupation.

- **Upload a CV**

- Jobseekers can improve their chances of getting job matches by uploading their CV to the EURES database.

- **My jobs**

- Jobseekers can create search profiles relevant to their positions in order to be notified of new jobs. They can also receive inquiries from employers or EURES staff interested in their profile.

- Europass is a free set of online tools and information that can assist jobseekers in managing all aspects of their learning and development. Jobseekers can also write a variety of CVs and cover letters, present abilities and qualifications, and handle relevant paperwork with Europass.
